

Hidden Asbestos in Your Place of Worship

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 require Dutyholders, i.e. those persons having control of non-domestic premises, carry out an Asbestos Assessment to determine the presence, or probable presence, of asbestos and, where necessary, have a written Asbestos Management Plan. Every church must, therefore, have such an assessment.

The Dutyholder is defined as the person in control of premises and would normally include whoever takes responsibility for maintenance and repairs.

Because compliance is a personal responsibility carrying potentially significant penalties for failing to act, you should carry out your Assessment without undue delay.

At the request of and in consultation with the Diocese of Gloucester, I have written detailed step by step guidance on assessing and managing asbestos in places of worship. Now this is available to you.

Suitable for use by all denominations and faiths, here is the information the Asbestos Removal Industry would prefer you did not know and your Architect probably wishes he did. It shows you how to find out whether you have any asbestos in or on your premises and how to do this safely. It then tells you exactly what to do if you do find or suspect the presence of asbestos. The end result is a complete record which can be kept with your other church papers.

Should you need to call in a contractor you will also find the manual, and the free follow up advice offered to all purchasers, could save you money as well as embarrassment.
